Position Summary

The primary objective is to support the Chemistry, Manufacturing and Control Department in the execution of the Company's Clinical Supply strategy by assisting in Technical Operations activities to ensure fully compliant Manufacturing and Packaging of Trevi's products. The selected candidate should be pursuing a major in a scientific field, have attentiveness to detail, good computer skills, and excellent written and oral communication skills. The goal is to help the intern develop a working knowledge of pharmaceutical manufacturing under all applicable Global Regulations and Guidances.

This is a paid, 20-40 hours per week internship position with a hybrid schedule consisting of 3 days in-person in New Haven, CT and one day working remotely. This position reports directly to the Vice President of CMC.

Principal Responsibilities

Key responsibilities of this role include, but are not limited to:

- Strategies and tactics for supplying clinical sites with study drug
- Evaluation of manufacturing processes for compliance with current regulatory requirements
- Evaluation of analytical process for compliance with global regulations
- Review of internal company quality documentation for accuracy and compliance
- Preparation or review of company regulatory procedures (SOPs, Work Instructions, etc.)
- Assist with review of vendor records

Haduvio is a dual κ -opioid receptor agonist and μ -opioid receptor antagonist that works both centrally in the brain as well as peripherally in the lungs and has the potential for a synergistic antitussive effect to treat chronic cough.
